

REPORT OF THE SPRING TERM VACATION FIELD TRIP OF VIETNAMESE
PARTICIPANTS IN POLICE FIELD

IN DETROIT:

We arrived in Detroit on June 7, 1960, at 6 p.m. The following day, June 8, 1960 we introduced ourselves to Superintendent LOUIS BERG at Detroit Police Headquarters.

Over there, we had a short briefing, involving to the visit of the Police Department. By the guidance of Lieutenant ROBERT POTTS, we visited simultaneously the show-up room, the positive identification, the temporary detention jail, the cell block, the woman's division, the Communication division, the dispatch bureau, the master record, the record bureau, the property room, the Detroit Police Academy, the Detective division, the Radio division, the Harbor master and the Crime Laboratory.

At the later, we spent most of our time in observing the procedure for separating the narcotics and the way of the examination on hairs.

After taking the complete tour around the Police Headquarters we were invited to have lunch.

Remarks: The Detroit Police Department has been organized perfectly. So we learned lots of experiences from its technicians. It might be useful for future participants to visit it.

On the other hand, the local authorities have a great deal of sympathy and courtesy to foreign visitors.

IN CHICAGO:

The program of visiting the House of Correction and Cook County Jail was set up by Sheriff FRANK G. SAIN, on June 16, 1960. According to his recommendations, we would visit:

- Cook County Jail
- House of Correction.

Cook County Jail: It was cancelled because the Superintendent WARDEN JOHNSON was very busy.

House of Correction: We were welcomed by Superintendent FRED K. HOEHLER. He appointed a correctional officer, as a guide to show us around the area.

Remarks.

We regret for not having opportunity to visit the Cook County Jail.

At the House of Correction, we did pay attention to the high standard of living of the inmates.

We hope we can adapt lots of interesting and good ideas from people who run this House of Correction, in ours in Viet-Nam.

On June 17, 1960, Father EMMANUEL JACQUES and Mr. Dominic TRAN-NGOC-BICH, Vice-President of the Vietnamese Students Association in Chicago came to see us at the Hotel. They showed us the good living of the people in Chicago and good information about many interesting places for sight seeing./.
