This training will enable the University of Saigon to become familiar with modern methods of teaching mathematics and leave the continental pattern of instruction now used exclusively in this country.

Upon his return, this participant will resume his normal teaching loads in mathematics. He will utilize the information and skills gained in the United States in his own courses. He will also conduct in-service seminars for his colleagues in mathematics. This local sharing will extend to instructors in the teacher training institutions of Vietnam and will ultimately influence mathematics instruction in the public schools as well as all mathematical work in the University itself.

This project is designed to expand and improve the University of Saigon, the only operating institution of higher learning in Vietnam. Specifically, participant training under this project is designed to extend the professional horizons and increase the teaching competencies of key faculty members.

Ours is the only American agency working directly on this problem. Much attention is being given to related aspects by the French Government and some similar assistance is being given by the Colombo Plan countries.

This participant desires additional training in the following areas of higher mathematics; mechanics and analytical mathematics. Primary emphasis should be given to the principal methods used in teaching these subjects in a major American University.

Participant desires study at one of the following universities: Harvard, Columbia or Princeton. This training will enable the University of Saigon to become familiar with modern methods of teaching mathematics and leave the continental pattern of instruction now used exclusively in this country.

Upon his return this participant will resume his normal teaching load in mathematics. This local sharing will extend to instructors in the teacher training institutions of Vietnam and will ultimately influence mathematics instruction in the public schools as well as all mathematical work in the University itself.
