Background

Born September 6, 1929 in Cantho, Viet-Nam, Mr. Tay attended schools in Viet-Nam, in France, and in England, graduating from the London City College in 1956. Prior to beginning his schooling abroad, Mr. Tay served for five years as manager of a pharmacy. He joined the staff of the U.S. Information Service in March 1957.

Present Duties

Mr. Tay is concerned primarily with the conduct of the Educational Exchange Program. He interviews candidates for scholarships; answers inquiries about study grants and about educational opportunities available in the United States; and processes applications for grants. He arranges conferences between American and Viet-Nam officials and serves as interpreter. His educational background and his knowledge of the local scene make him valuable as an adviser on all phases of the USIS program.

Suggestions for Orientation

Visits to various educational institutions with opportunity to observe methods of classroom instruction, available research facilities, and extra-curricular activities.

Introduction to Americans of various background and interests; opportunity to observe a cross section of the American scene.
