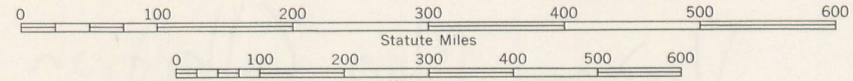

In order to avoid congestion and unnecessary clutter, the map does not show the names of all cities.

NOTE: On this map, "Urban Areas" applies both to municipalities and to other cities with sizeable populations. A municipality (shih) is an administrative unit that consists of one or more cities and adjacent area. Population figures apply to the entire administrative area of the municipalities. In order to avoid congestion and unnecessary repetition, the generic "Shih" for municipality has been omitted from the name; for example, San-men-hsia Shih appears as San-men-hsia.
