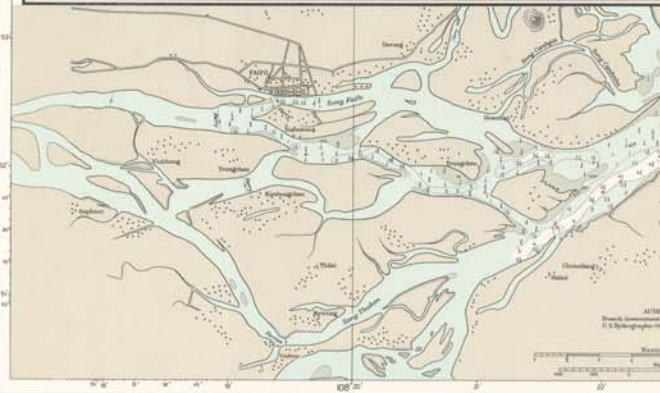
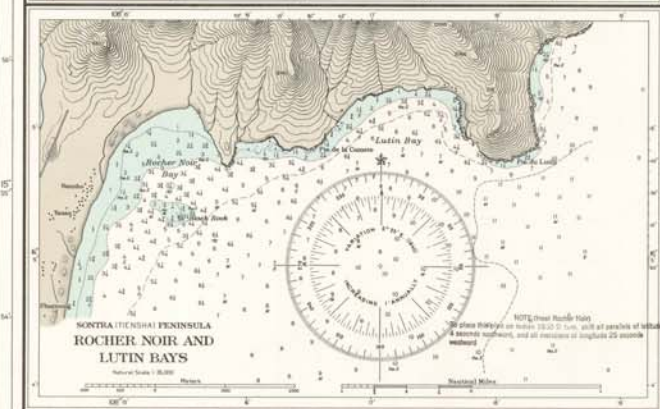
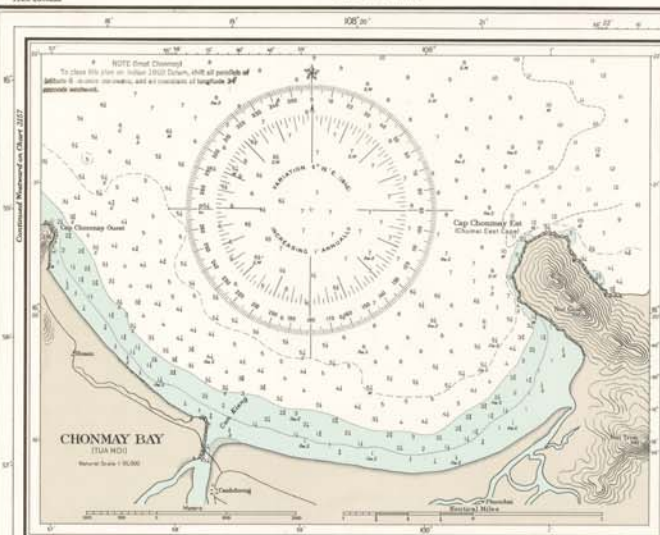

To place the ring on the 100° datum, start at a position of latitude 7° (latitude may be zero), and at meridians of longitude 20 seconds westward, i.e. at $100^\circ 00' 20.00''$ change the coordinate value of charted latitude to $10^\circ 00' 00.00''$.
